1. **Are We There Yet?** Dan Santat. A boy goes on a long car ride to visit his grandmother and discovers time moves faster depending on how bored he is. **Lexile 310 Points 1**
2. **The Bear Who Wasn't There.** LeUyen Pham. A picture book inviting readers to join the hilarious search for a missing bear. **TEST NOT YET AVAILABLE**
3. **Dear Dragon : A Pen Pal Tale.** Josh Funk. As a school project, George and Blaise become pen pals, writing rhyming letters about their favorite things to do, unaware that one is human and the other a dragon. **TEST NOT YET AVAILABLE**
4. **Dog Rules.** Jef Czekaj. A bird tries to raise a new puppy, but finds it's a lot more complicated than he imagined. **TEST NOT YET AVAILABLE**
5. **Dragon Was Terrible.** Kelly DiPucchio. When a dragon has a temper tantrum, no one can tame him, except for a little boy with a good book. **Lexile 370 Points 1**
6. **Eddie The Bully.** Henry Cole. Eddie enjoys being mean and bullying his fellow students until a new girl arrives and shows him how good it can feel to be nice. **TEST NOT YET AVAILABLE**
7. **The Gingerbread Man Loose At The Zoo.** Laura Murray. When the gingerbread man gets separated from his class during a field trip to the zoo, he uses his teacher's animal scavenger hunt to find his way back to them. **Lexile 450 Points 1**
8. **Hippopotamister.** John Green. Hippo isn't happy. But what can he do? What hippo really needs . . . is a job where he can be himself. **Lexile 540 Points 2**
9. **Hotel Bruce.** Ryan Higgins. A reluctant mother to four young geese, grumpy Bruce the bear loses his temper when he migrates home in the spring only to discover that mice have converted his den into a hotel. **Lexile 300 Points 1**

11. Madeline And The Library Dog. Lisa Papp. Reluctant reader Madeline really wants to earn a star at school, so when Mrs. Dimple, the librarian, suggests she read to a dog, Madeline decides to give it a try. **Lexile 370 Points 1**
12. Mary Had A Little Glam. Tammi Sauer. In this fun take on a familiar nursery rhyme, fashion-forward Mary helps some of childhoods most beloved characters go glam.

17. They All Saw A Cat. Brendan Wentzel. In simple, rhythmic prose and stylized pictures, a cat walks through the world, and all the other creatures see and acknowledge the cat.
