

Bus Safety

- Students are expected to be respectful and cooperate with the driver at all times.
- Students are expected to keep head, hands, and feet inside the bus.
- Students are expected to use inside voices while riding the bus.
- Students are expected to use appropriate language at all times.
- **Students should inform the bus driver if a problem occurs.**
- All student items must be secured.
- Students must follow all stated rules that are in the Student Handbook.
- Consequences will be given to students choosing to not follow expectations.

IMPORTANT!

Bus Procedure Changes 2015

For your child's safety:

- Students can have only **one** pick-up and **one**-drop off point. These permanent fixed points prevent confusion for student.
- End of day transportation changes must be made prior to 1:00 p.m.
- Students can only ride their assigned bus.
- Students must only use assigned pick-up and drop-off point.
- Kindergarten and first grade parents must be present at drop off point.

Daycare Info

- All student daycare enrollment information must be provided and updated yearly to your child's school. Students will NOT be provided transportation to daycare until updated information has been provided.
- Your child's daycare must be within your school's drop-off routes.
- Contact your school for daycares within your school's drop-off routes.
